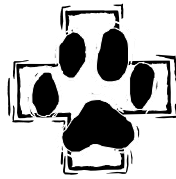

Dog Obedience Classes

Is your dog in need of some serious discipline? Help your pet understand what you want. Commands covered will include heel, sit, come, down, stay, place, and stand stay. Dogs/puppies must be four months old and must have had all their DHLPP and Rabies shots. Proof of vaccinations *must* be presented on first day of class. Class requires a four or six foot nylon or leather leash and a regular collar.

Mind of Their Own Dog Training uses only positive training techniques. The methods used are The Clicker (Operant Conditioning) /Lure & Reward. Participants will receive a training folder, a clicker, and a book on how to use The Clicker! (7 weeks)
