Letter from the District Administrator

Dear Carmichael Community,

I hope this letter finds you well. It is with mixed emotions that I write my final letter to the community, as I will be retiring on December 6th. Over the past five years at CRPD, we have experienced numerous changes that have positively impacted the Carmichael community and will continue to do so in the future.

Since my last letter, we have had some exciting developments, and I want to update you on them.

In response to valuable feedback from the public and our sponsors, we launched a new pilot program for Concerts in the Park. The new spring concert dates were extremely successful, and we look forward to the upcoming fall dates, all while avoiding the extremely hot summer weather.

I'd also like to share many of the Measure G projects that you will see coming to our park system in the near future. We have hired landscape architects for projects at Cardinal Oaks, Glancy Oaks, La Sierra, and Carmichael Park. These projects include replacing the outdated playgrounds at Glancy Oaks Park and Cardinal Oaks Park. Additionally, pathways in these parks will be updated to meet ADA standards. Cardinal Oaks will also see additional lighting and a new parking lot added (with ARPA funding through Supervisor Desmond's Office). At La Sierra Community Center, there will be a renovation of the soccer field (including the two baseball fields) and the final phase of re-roofing and replacement of old/outdated HVAC systems. Major projects are also planned for Carmichael Park, including the replacement of the Tiny Tot Playground near the Veteran's Memorial Hall, repaving several areas of the park, adding a new restroom near the tennis courts, and converting two tennis courts to pickleball courts. For several of these projects, we will be seeking public input, especially when replacing the existing playgrounds at Cardinal, Glancy, and Carmichael Parks. Furthermore, I'm thrilled to announce that the LSCC Phase II re-roofing is complete and once again came in under budget!

Additionally, CRPD still has the Series II and III bond sales that will fund projects at Del Campo, Sutter-Jensen, Bird Track, Jan, O'Donnell, and Patriots Parks. It will also see the paving of the parking lots at La Serra Community Center and Carmichael Park. The Advisory Board and staff are also working on improvements for the Schweitzer Grove Nature Area in the coming years using non-Measure G funds.

Even with all of that going on, the Advisory Board and staff have been working with the public on a rendering and cost analysis for a skatepark at Carmichael Park. The skatepark has been part of the Carmichael Park Master Plan since 2014. The Advisory Board funded the rendering and cost analysis through non-Measure G funds. We had two well attended focus groups and a community meeting to gather insights from skaters and other community members. The next step will be working with the supporters of the skatepark on fundraising for the construction of this new amenity.



Finally, we used non-Measure G funds to purchase and install an electronic reader board on Fair Oaks Blvd in Carmichael Park. This will allow us to communicate our events and programs with the public on a more consistent (and colorful) basis.

There is so much more going on with our recreation programs, building rentals, and special events than in previous years, as our staff has continued to re-imagine what we provide to the community. It's a team effort between our parks, recreation and administrative staff that makes it all happen, along with the great leadership of our Advisory Board. As we continue our journey forward, I encourage you to stay connected with us through our website and social media channels. Join us on Facebook and Instagram to stay informed about upcoming events and exciting developments within our community. Remember that our monthly Advisory Board meetings are on the third Thursday of the month (6 pm) at the Carmichael Clubhouse at Carmichael Park (5750 Grant Ave.) and can be attended in-person or online.

As I mentioned earlier, my long career in the parks and recreation field is coming to an end. My first job in the profession was as a 15-year-old youth basketball coach, and I could not have imagined then that I would have a 43-year career. I found the perfect ending spot for my career in overseeing the Carmichael Recreation and Park District. The Advisory Board, staff, Parks Foundation, and community have been welcoming and supportive throughout my time here.

The search for my replacement is well underway, and the plan is to have the new District Administrator in place this November. I look forward to spending some of my time here in Carmichael in the future taking part in volunteer efforts. This isn't goodbye, just see you around!




