
Glancy Oaks Park Site Plan






### SURVEY SUMMARY - AMENITIES

- 62 respondents
- 57% of people visit the park daily
- The play equipment is 34% of people's favorite amenity and almost equally tied with walking paths and open grassy areas
- 63% of people prefer low-maintanance groundcovers and 42% prefer low-maintanance shrubs
- Trash receptacles, seat walls, benches and dog waste dispensers are amenities that the majority would like to see in the renovation



### SURVEY SUMMARY - PLAY AREA

- -About 60% think shade and more age-appropriate equipment are improvements the park could benefit from
- Over 80% of people would like to see a natural and earthy color scheme and a nature theme for the play equipment
- About 80% would like to see climbing structures and swings implemented into the playground redesign with typical post and deck and rope play closely behind


